**As we approach the busiest time of our exam season we would like to update you on some important information regarding Year 11 students.**

### **Study Leave and Party**

Year 11 will leave school on **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May at 12pm**. There is a farewell party at Coventry University Student Union from 1.30 p.m. until 3.00 p.m. Tickets are £1 and can be purchased from House Heads.

### **Uniform**

Students do not have to wear school uniform on **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May** but **MUST** wear uniform for **ALL exams** and **revision classes** in June. Failure to wear uniform will result in disruption to the start of exams. Any student not wearing uniform will not be allowed to go to the Year 11 leavers Prom.

After the exams we will buy back any unwanted school uniform if it is in good clean condition:

Students will need to bring items into school (after their last exam) and see their House Head for payment.


## 16+ Induction Days
